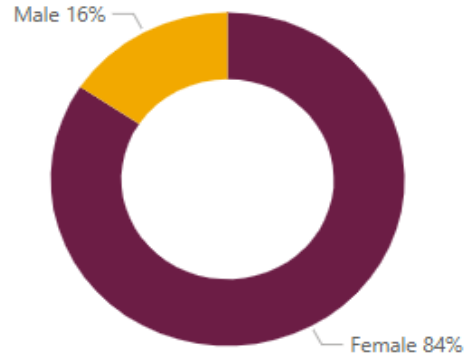

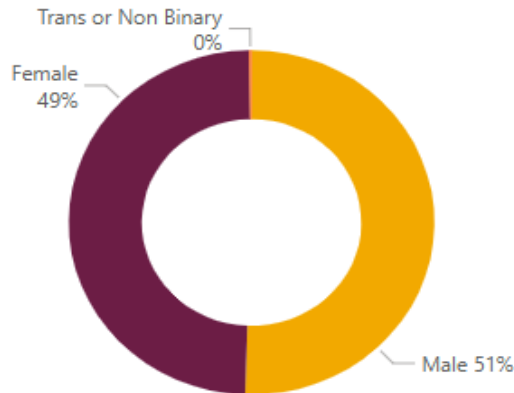

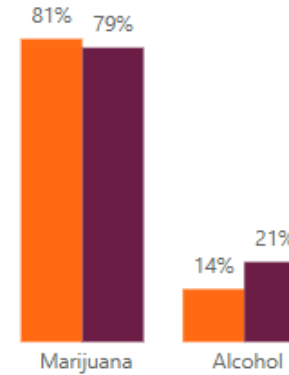


### Children's Genders

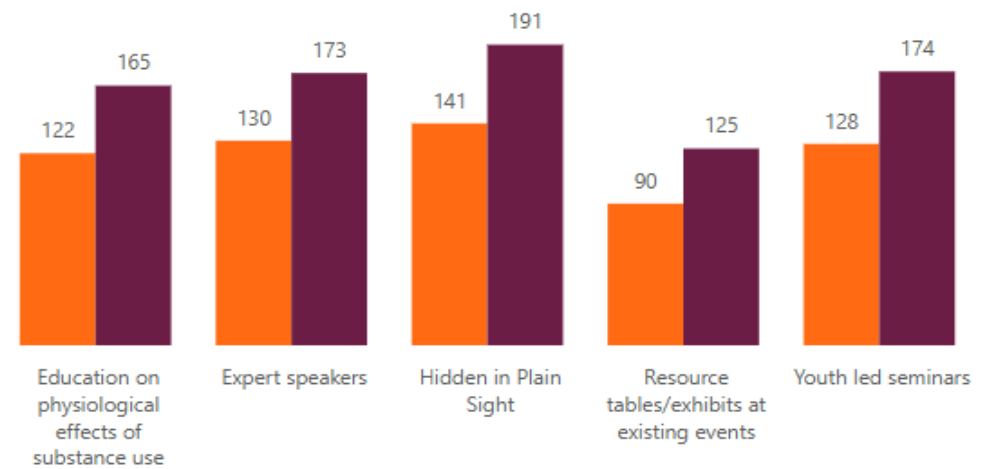

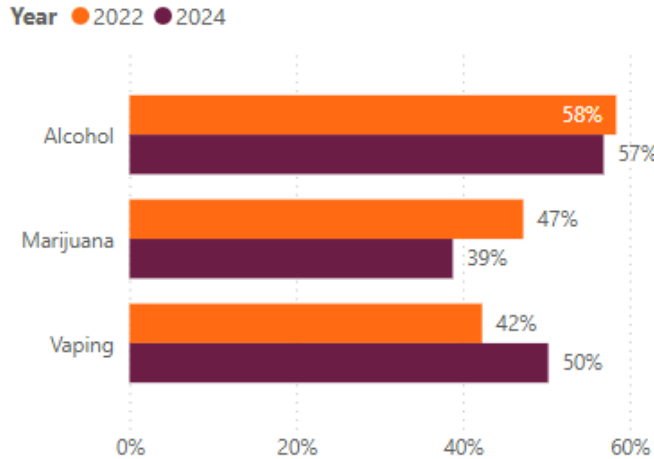

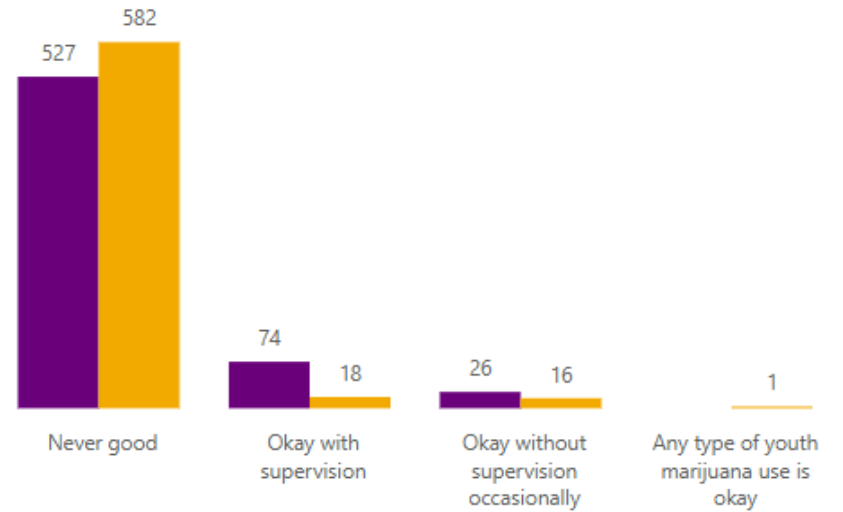

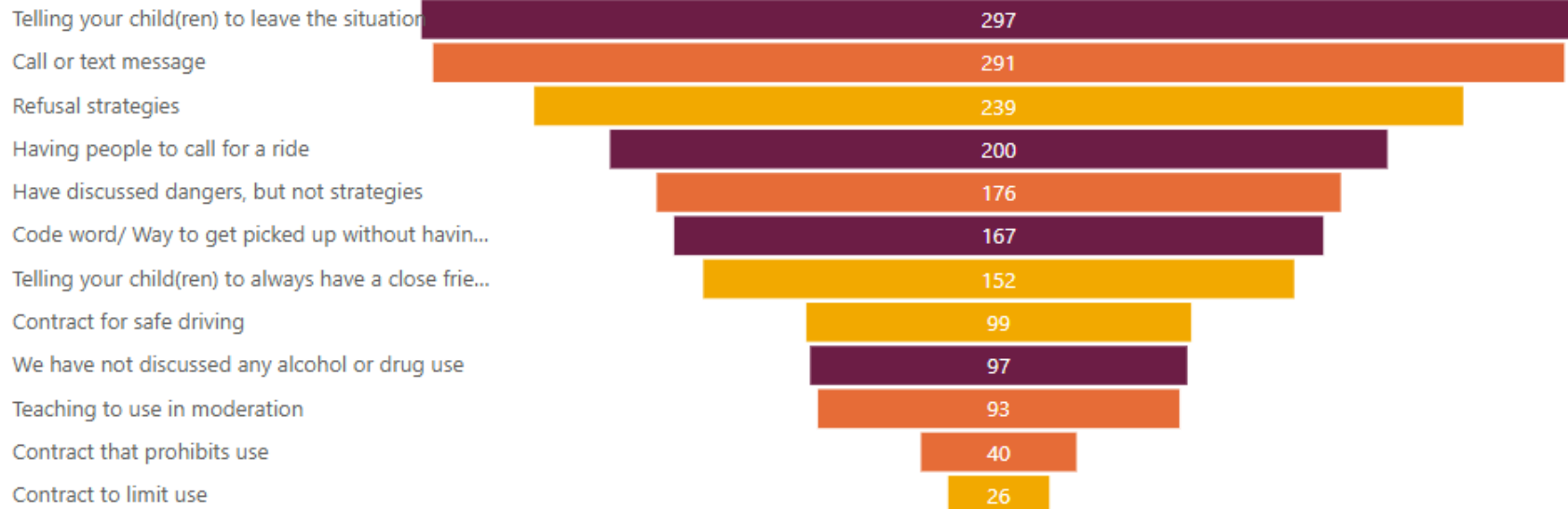

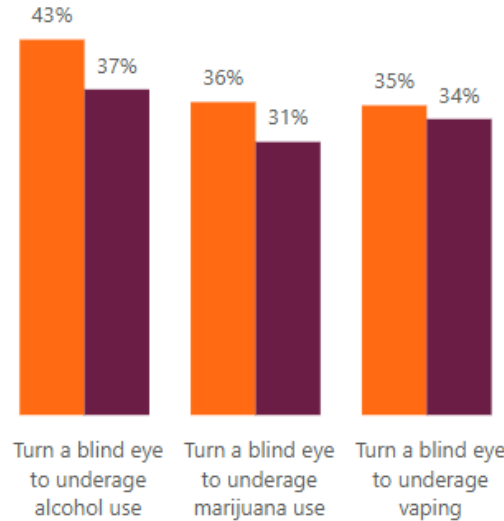

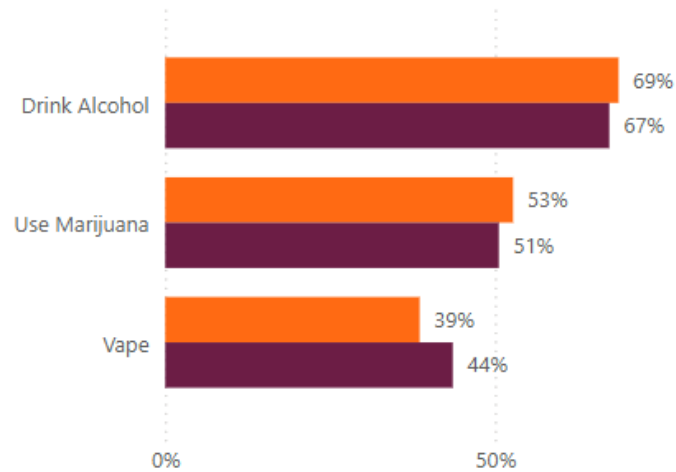

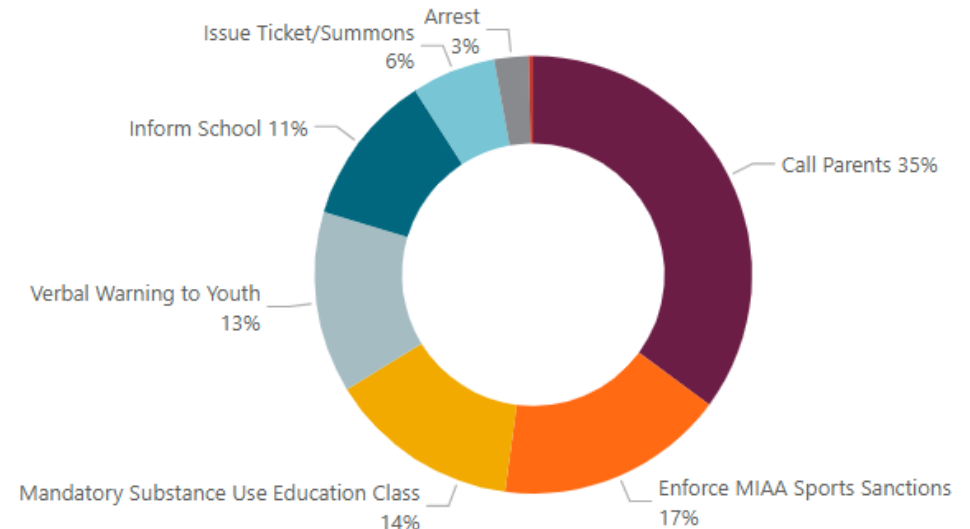
